The dangers of messing with activation when handling a WM_ACTIVATE message

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This is basically the same thing as <u>The dangers of playing focus games when handling a</u> <u>WM_KILLFOCUS message</u>, just with activation in place of focus. <u>One developer discovered</u> <u>the hard way that if you mess with activation inside your WM_ACTIVATE handler, things get</u> <u>weird</u>. The author noted that if he posted a message and did the work from the posted message, then everything came out okay.

<u>A follow-up to the original message</u> noted that passing the <u>SWP_NOACTIVATE</u> flag to the <u>SetWindowPos</u> function solves the problem. Do you understand why?

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
