<u>Jensen Harris</u>'s brief example of <u>using Excel's random number generator</u> reminded me that I had need for the random number generator recently myself: Generating <u>buzzword bingo</u> cards.

At the <u>Battlestar Galactica party</u>, our hosts needed to create some Battlestar Galacticathemed buzzword bingo cards and asked me to help out. Here's how I did it:

- 1. Build a list of words and phrases in column A.
- 2. In column B, next to each word or phrase, enter "=rand()". You can use Jensen's "block entry" trick.
- 3. Build your bingo card elsewhere on the sheet.
- 4. In the upper left square of the bingo card, enter "=A1"; in the next square, "=A2", and so on.
- 5. Highlight cell B1.
- 6. Click the "Sort ascending" button on the toolbar.
- 7. Print your bingo card.
- 8. Repeat steps 6 and 7 until satisfied.

It's not beautiful, but it gets the job done.
