Fact check: The first major Microsoft product launched via Webcast

In 2009, while hosting the Webcast launch of Office Communications Server 2007 R2 (what a mouthful; no wonder they renamed it Lync), <u>Stephen Elop claimed that this was the first time Microsoft had launched a major product via Webcast</u>. Elop's crack team of marketing researchers apparently forgot about <u>the Webcast launch</u>, just three months earlier, of Windows Small Business Server 2008. Maybe somebody can find an even earlier Webcast launch of a major Microsoft product.

(Perhaps Elop is claiming that Small Business Server is not a major product, but by that standard, neither is Office Communications Server, which is arguably even more of a niche product than SBS.)
