## How do I obtain the computer manufacturer's name from C++?

Some time ago, I gave <u>a scripting solution to the problem of obtaining the computer</u> <u>manufacturer and model</u>. But what if you want to do this from C++?

I could translate the script into C++, or I could just point you to <u>Creating a WMI Application</u> <u>Using C++</u> in MSDN. In particular, one of the <u>WMI C++ Sample Applications</u> does exactly what you want: <u>Example: Creating a WMI Application</u>. The only things you need to do are

- change SELECT \* FROM Win32\_Process to SELECT \* FROM Win32 ComputerSystem, and
- change Name to Manufacturer, and then again to Model.
