How does Task Manager compute Up Time, and why doesn't it agree with GetTickCount?

Task Manager shows a piece of information called "Up time". How is this value calculated, and why doesn't it agree with the value reported by <code>GetTickCount</code> / <code>GetTickCount64</code>? Task Manager calculates "up time" by subtracting the system boot time from the current time. In other words, it is misnamed; it really should be called *time since system was started*. It doesn't subtract out the time when the computer was in sleep or hibernation.

The tick count, on the other hand, counts only time that elapses while the computer is on.
